Services for Legacy Resource Holders

- **Introduction**

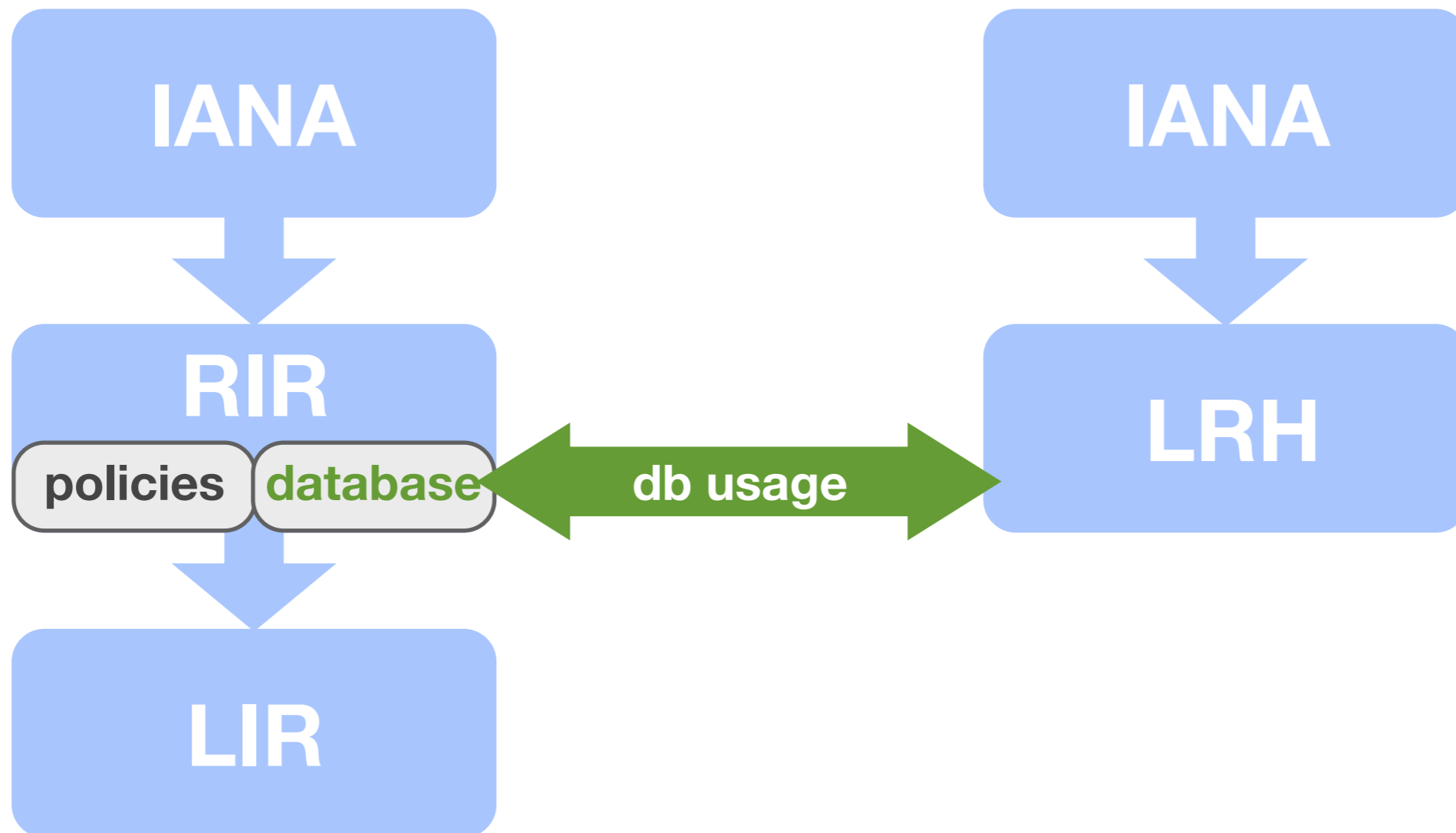
- **Legacy Resources:** assignments pre-date RIRs, from IANA or IR

- **Holders:**

- early adopters
- variety of organizations
- sustained support for RIPE and RIPE NCC
- through RARE, provided initial home for NCC
- gave initial credibility to RIPE DB
- haven't gone away ...

Services for Legacy Resource Holders

- **How Legacy Resource Holders relate to RIRs** (*simplified*)



Services for Legacy Resource Holders

- **Situation**

- NCC and Legacy Resource Holders have drifted apart
 - NCC focus on allocating new resources to LIRs
 - Legacy resource holders typically not LIRs
- Degradation of data quality
 - sometimes despite efforts of resource holders
 - frustrating nuisance: reflects badly on RIR
- New NCC focus on registration & certification
- Need to engage and work together

 - 4-stage outreach plan, starting with pilot group
- Options: membership or sponsoring LIR (as for PI)
- Holdings immediately subject to all RIPE policies
- Motivation: RIR responsibility (not policy)
- Charging TF refers to “carrot and stick” approach

Services for Legacy Resource Holders

- **What we're looking for**
 - Clear policy basis
 - Derived from stakeholder consensus
 - We expect to have to do some work
 - Clarity as to charges and corresponding services
 - Rectification of outstanding problems
 - **before** proposed freeze

Services for Legacy Resource Holders

- **What we think should be avoided** (*from what people tell us ...*)
 - Heavy-handed “RIR responsibility” approach
 - Requirement to submit legacy resources to RIPE policies
 - likely obstacle for holders
 - [the carrot is on the other side of a deep ditch!]
