Ripe-501 Where Did it Start

- Original document was sourced from the Slovenian government and Go6
- Translated by some volunteers with help of the RIPE NCC
- Pretty much a literal translation
- Presented at RIPE 61 in Rome
- Pushed out pretty quickly because there was a lot of demand and not many comments



Replacing ripe-501

- There was a discussion at RIPE 62 about some things that should be changed:
 - Reference some new documents
 - Add some new profiles for CPE and mobile devices
- Updating a RIPE Document means replacing it

Where Are We Now?

- A draft replacement was cycled to the mailing list and put in last call just before RIPE 63
- During the meeting some suggestions for improvement were made
- Authors decided to edit the draft based on that feedback
