Purpose Of 2012-01

- Allow transfer of IPv4 addresses to / from other RIR's
- Supplement the pool of IPv4 addresses available to the RIPE region
- Provide access to IPv4 addresses should companies in the RIPE service region need them
- Ensure the RIPE IPv4 database accurately reflects IPv4 transfers



Body of Proposal

- The RIPE NCC will recognize inter-RIR IPv4
 address transfers only when the counterpart RIR
 has an inter-RIR transfer policy that permits the
 transfer of address space between the RIPE NCC
 service region and its own region.
- The RIPE NCC will process and record IPv4
 address transfer requests between current RIPE
 NCC account holders and organizations in other
 RIR regions subject to the following conditions.

Conditions

- On Space
 - -/24
 - Authentic holder
- On Source
 - Defined by the RIR where block is held
- On Recipient
 - Defined by the RIR where block is held
 - When in RIPE NCC, affidavit from signing officer that will not be re-transferred in 15 months, for operational purposes, conform with anti-spam directive

Feedback Received

- Notion that Inter-RIR transfers should simply follow the same rules as intra-RIR transfers
- Preference for use of the word "transfer" rather than "sale"
- Why limit re-transfer period to 15 months
- Why minimum transfer block /24



Path Forward

- Withdraw 2012-01
- Simplify Inter-RIR Transfer Proposal with 2012-02 which Remco will now present
- Introduce 2012-03 to make Timeline Amendments for all Transfers
 - No limitation on the period of use which is transferred
